Update – Winter Storm 2014 –

It was announced that the Board would receive an update on last week's storm at today's Board meeting under Agenda Item #8: Other Matters.

Legislative Update

This year's session is moving very fast at the Capitol. Today marks the eighteenth (18) day of the forty (40) day session. The overall environment has been very positive for MARTA.

Financial Disclosure

Section 9 of MARTA's Code of Ethics requires Financial Disclosure by the Board of Directors, General Manager, Chief Operating Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Chief Information Officer, Assistant General Managers, Executive Directors, Sr. Directors, Directors and certain supervisory/management employees within the Finance Department, Legal Services and the Audit Department.

Briefing – Performance Assessment Initiative

The Performance Assessment Initiative is a market research study that involves a multiprong approach:

- a) Performed a market research study asking customers why they ride or not ride. For those that stopped riding what would it take to get them to come back, etc.
- b) A Comprehensive Operations Analysis which looks at every bus route, rail services and Mobility services
- c) MARTA is also taking a deep look at performance in meeting both internal and external expectations

Resolution Authorizing Issuance of a Work Order to Georgia Power

This resolution authorizes the issuance of a Work Order with Georgia Power for the relocation of MARTA's electrical service duct bank.

Other Matters

Atlanta Streetcar – MARTA is working with the City of Atlanta to finalize operations. MARTA has been asked to explore the possibility of running the service.

Clayton County Service – there is a potential for restarting bus service in Clayton County. There will be a number of meetings regarding Clayton service, moving forward.

Governor's Task Force for Severe Weather – Mr. Parker will reach out to MARTA Board members for feedback that MARTA wants to communicate to the Governor's office that will help position MARTA in the future.

Midtown Alliance has come back with recommendations on how to improve the external look of several MARTA stations.

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On motion by Dr. Edmond seconded by Mr. Daniels, the Board unanimously agreed to go into Executive Session at 12:54 potential litigation and a real estate matter.
